The meeting was called to order by the Chairman at 8:07 a.m.

#### **ROLL CALL:**

Roll call was taken, all directors were present.

#### PUBLIC BUSINESS FROM THE FLOOR:

No public comment.

#### CONSENT CALENDAR:

Al Montna read the rules and the items for consent. Charlie Hoppin moved to approve the minutes for the June 10, 2023 Regular Board Meeting and to approve Items 2 and 3 of the Consent Calendar (review and approval of claims for payment submitted by the Levee District and review and approval of claims for payment submitted by the R.V. Park). Gary Marler seconded the motion. The matter was put to a vote and votes were cast as follows:

The motion to approve the minutes for the June 10, 2023 Regular Board Meeting and to approve Items 2 and 3 of the Consent Calendar for the claims submitted by the Levee District in the amount of \$120.00 and the RV Park in the amount of \$700.00 was carried.

### PRESENTATION, DISCUSSION, AND ACTION ITEMS:



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- Consider and discuss Draft Budget for the District for Fiscal Year 23/24
   The District Engineer and General Manager went over the draft budget with the Board. Discussion ensued. District Counsel explained that the Final Budget for Fiscal Year 23/24 would be included as an action item on the agenda for the August meeting.
- 2. Consider and discuss approval of \$50.00 increase to rental rates for the Feather River RV Park through the remainder of the 2023 calendar year and an additional increase of \$50.00 during every calendar year thereafter.

Al Montna made a motion to approve a 10% annual increase to rental rates for the Feather River RV Park beginning in the 2024 calendar year and rounding up or down to the nearest whole number every calendar year thereafter. Charlie Hoppin seconded the motion.

District Counsel described numerous attempts requesting an Amended OMRR&R Agreement to Include Maintenance Area 3 from the Central Valley Flood Control Board Staff, at the time of the Board Meeting no Agreement had been provided.

4. Consider and discuss Second Street Fence Crossing Levee.

The Board reviewed and discussed the O'Banion levee easement grant dated November 9, 1938 and the District's obligations thereunder. It was reported that the Yuba City Police Department sent a letter to the 2<sup>nd</sup> Street property owners notifying them to contact the Police Department if the fence crossing is vandalized or trespassed. The Board determined that additional resources for a new fence was not required at this time.
