Re: Floodplain Management - Unpermitted Structures and Debris Obstructing the Floodplain

Dear Colleagues:

We write on behalf of Levee District No.1 of Sutter County (LD1) and Sutter Butte Flood Control Agency (SBFCA). All of our respective agencies have a vested interest in floodplain management in Sutter County. LD1 has made multiple attempts to bring attention to the health and safety hazards that exist within the local floodplain. In the past, LD1 has worked with the County and other local agencies and assisted with the removal of unpermitted structures and debris obstructing the floodplain. Unfortunately, progress on these efforts has been stalled for some time. The results of these past efforts have now been lost as the unpermitted structures and debris from the inhabitants has grown to pre-cleanup levels. We write to notify you of these existing hazards within our local floodplain and request your immediate assistance to abate and resolve this issue which poses a significant threat to the people and property of Sutter County.

Sutter County Ordinance Chapter 1780 mandates that the floodplain be kept free of all unpermitted structures and debris. Failure to comply with Chapter 1780 endangers the life and property of the local population. "The cumulative effect of obstructions...increase flood heights and velocities" which contribute to and potentially exacerbate flood losses which may include "health and safety hazards, disruption of commerce and governmental services, extraordinary public expenditures for flood protection and relief, and impairment of the tax base, all of which adversely affect the public health, safety and general welfare."

Any damage caused by flooding could be alleged to result from the failure to maintain the floodplain as required by Chapter 1780. LD1 and SBFCA believe that failure to enforce Chapter 1780 exposes the County and other local agencies to enormous risk and potential liability. We therefore write this letter to remind all of our local agencies of the responsibilities that Chapter 1780 imposes and enlist your assistance and support in addressing the dangerous hazard that exists. Please know that LD1 and SBFCA will continue to be here to assist in these efforts.
